Position Description: Milwaukee State Senator Lena C. Taylor is seeking undergraduate and graduate student interns to work in our State Capitol for a minimum of 10 hours per week during the summer. These high energy internships are unpaid but will provide valuable political experience and helpful insight into state government. This is a fast-paced office with a great deal of opportunity to gain real experience in handling judicial case work and building community relationships. Previous interns have helped citizens reenter their communities from prison, connected constituents with community resources, and helped them to navigate state agencies and frustrating government bureaucracies.

Representing one of the most diverse districts in the state, this office offers interns the ability to work on many different issues and take the lead on issues and tasks that interest them most. If you care about social justice, education, and job creation, then this is the internship for you. An interest in a career in politics, or public policy welcomed but not required.

Senator Lena C. Taylor is the 1,000 Wisconsin State Senator, 20th woman, 5th African American, 2nd African American woman and just the first African American woman to serve as the co-chair of the powerful Joint Committee on Finance.

Qualifications: Applicants should be well-organized and detail-oriented, as well as exhibit critical reading and writing skills. Applicants should demonstrate strong communication skills and a willingness to learn on the job. Ability to work well independently as well as part of a team is a must.
